PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION G-10371 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Avion Water Co., Inc., 60813 Parrell Road, Bend, Oregon 97701, phone 382-5342 for use of the waters of 3 wells, being 0.14 cubic foot per second from Well 1; 0.02 cfs from Well 2 and 0.11 cfs from Well 3 (Tetherow)

for the PURPOSE of group domestic use for 83 families including the irrigation of lawn and garden not to exceed one-half acre for each

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from June 11, 1981

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.27 cfs

measured at the point of diversion from the wells , or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The well is to be LOCATED: Well 1 - 1,860 feet South and 2,475 feet West from the Northeast Corner of Section 36, being within the SW 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 36; Well 2-350 feet South and 280 feet West from the Northeast Corner, Section 36, being within the NE 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 36; Well 3-640 feet South and 568 feet East from the Northwest Corner of Section 36, being * A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

* within the NW 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 36; all within Township 14 South, Range 12 East, WM, in the County of Deschutes.

The well shall be constructed in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon. The works constructed shall include an air line and pressure gauge or an access port for measuring line, adequate to determine water level elevation in the well at all times. The permittee shall install and maintain a weir, meter, or other suitable measuring device, and shall keep a complete record of the amount of ground water withdrawn.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before April 15, 1984 , and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1984 . Extended to October 1, 1988 Extended to October 1, 1989
