PERMIT to CONSTRUCT a RESERVOIR and to STORE for BENEFICIAL USE the PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION R-68006 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS AND THE FOLLOWING LIMITATIONS AND CONDITIONS:

This permit is issued to Gebhard Orchards by Edwin W. and Franklin H. Gebhard of 446 Beebe Road, Central Point, Oregon 97502, phone 664-1841 or 664-2235, for the construction of Gebhard Reservoir and storage of water from an unnamed swale, with any deficiency in the available supply from the unnamed swale to be made up from the South Fork Little Butte Creek with any deficiency in the available supply from * The dam will be LOCATED in the: SW 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 1, Township 37 South, Range 2 West, WM, in the County of Jackson.

The maximum height will be 9.0 feet above the stream bed or ground surface at the centerline. The top width will be 10.0 feet, slope of upstream face 3:1, slope of downstream face 2:1, and height of dam above water line when full 1.5 feet

The area submerged by the reservoir, when full, will be 1.0 acre, and the maximum depth of water will be 8.0 feet

* South Fork Little Butte Creek to be made up from North Fork Little Butte Creek to be appropriated under Application 68007, Permit 48870 for temperature control.

The location and dimensions of the spillway are: Two 10 inch concrete pipes at upper end of south end of fill.

The location and dimension of the outlet conduit will be: 675 feet North and 1160 feet East from the W 1/4 Corner of Section 1 through bottom of dam using a 10 inch outlet pipe with control valves.

The structure is out of the channel.

The dam will be earthfill construction.

The right hereunder shall be limited to the storage of 4.2 acre-feet

The PRIORITY DATE of this permit is January 27, 1984 .

Actual construction work shall begin on or before October 30, 1985, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1986 .
