PERMIT to CONSTRUCT a RESERVOIR and to STORE for BENEFICIAL USE the PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION R-68143 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS AND THE FOLLOWING LIMITATIONS AND CONDITIONS:

This permit is issued to Carl Anderson of PO Box 206, Grand Ronde, Oregon 97347, phone 879-5252 or 879-5108, for the construction of two reservoirs and storage of water from Rock Creek, a tributary of South Yamhill River, to be maintained under Application 68144, Permit 48878 for recreation.

The dam will be LOCATED in the: NW 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 13, Township 6 South, Range 8 West, WM, in the County of Polk.

The maximum height will be 2.0 feet above the stream bed or ground surface at the centerline. The top width will be * , slope of upstream face 10.0 , slope of downstream face 10.0 , and height of dam above water line when full 2.0 feet

The area submerged by the reservoir, when full, will be 0.35 acre , and the maximum depth of water will be 3.0 feet

* 40.0 feet, 25.0 feet

The location and dimensions of the spillway are 3.0 inch conduits through dams. The distance between the crests of the dams and the crests of the conduits will be 2.5 feet.

The location and dimension of the outlet conduit will be: None.

The structure is out of the channel.

No dams are required; reservoirs are excavated.

The right hereunder shall be limited to the storage of 1.3 acre-feet, being 0.25 af in Reservoir 1 and 1.05 af in Reservoir 2

The PRIORITY DATE of this permit is August 2, 1984

Actual construction work shall begin on or before October 30, 1985, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1986.
