**PERMIT to CONSTRUCT a RESERVOIR and to STORE
for BENEFICIAL USE the PUBLIC WATERS**

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION R-68185 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS AND THE FOLLOWING LIMITATIONS AND CONDITIONS:

This permit is issued to M.H. Higginson of Route 3, Box 365, Newberg, Oregon 97132, phone 538-9600, for the construction of a reservoir and storage of water from an unnamed intermittent stream, a tributary of Chehalem Creek for stock water,

The dam will be LOCATED in the: SW 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 21, Township 2 South, Range 3 West, WM, in the County of Yamhill.

The maximum height will be 9.11 feet above the stream bed or ground surface at the centerline. The top width will be 10.0 , slope of upstream face 3:1 , slope of downstream face 2:1 , and height of dam above water line when full 1.0 foot

The area submerged by the reservoir, when full, will be 0.23 acre , and the maximum depth of water will be 9.0 feet

The location and dimensions of the spillway are: The bottom width of the spillway will be 10.0 feet. The top width of the spillway will be 14.0 feet. The distance between the crest of the dam and the crest of the spillway will be 1.0 foot.

The location and dimension of the outlet conduit will be: A 6 inch culvert placed at the bottom of the dam.

The structure is in the channel.

The dam will be earthfill construction.

The right hereunder shall be limited to the storage of 0.7 acre-foot

The PRIORITY DATE of this permit is September 21, 1984

Actual construction work shall begin on or before October 30, 1985 , and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 86 .
