## PERMIT to CONSTRUCT a RESERVOIR and to STORE for BENEFICIAL USE the PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION R-68214 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS AND THE FOLLOWING LIMITATIONS AND CONDITIONS:

This permit is issued to Noble Mountain Tree Farm of 5115 Bethel Heights Road, NW, Salem, Oregon 97304, phone 364-2383, for the construction of two unnamed reservoirs and storage of water from an unnamed drainageway, a tributary of King Creek to be maintained by appropriation of water under Application 68215, Permit 49000 for recreation,

The dam will be LOCATED in the: SE 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 14, Township 6 South, Range 4 West, WM, in the County of Polk.

The maximum height will be feet above the stream bed or ground surface at the centerline. The top width will be slope of upstream face 3:1, slope of downstream face 2:1, and height of dam above water line when full 3.0 feet

The area submerged by the reservoir, when full, will be

, and the maximum depth of water will be  $12.0\,$  feet

\* Dam 1 - 9.5 feet; Dam 2 - 9.0 feet

\*\* Dam 1 - 10.0 feet; Dam 2 - 12.0 feet \*\*\* Dam 1 - 0.48 acre; Dam 2 - 0.35 acre

The location and dimensions of the spillway are: None.

The location and dimension of the outlet conduit will be: None.

The structure is in the channel.

The dam will be earthfill construction.

The right hereunder shall be limited to the storage of 6.5 acre-feet, being 3.5 acre-feet in Reservoir 1 and 3.0 af in Reservoir 2

The PRIORITY DATE of this permit is October 31, 1984.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before December 21, 1985, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1986.
