## PERMIT to CONSTRUCT a RESERVOIR and to STORE for BENEFICIAL USE the PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION R-65217 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS AND THE FOLLOWING LIMITATIONS AND CONDITIONS:

This permit is issued to US Forest Service - Deschutes National Forest of 211 NE Revere, Bend, Oregon 97701, phone 382-6922, for the construction of Prairie Farm Reservoir and storage of water from Prairie Farm Creek, a tributary of Fly Creek for wildlife use and is subject to the installation and maintenance of an outlet pipe, or to provide other means to evacuate the stored water when determined by the Water \*

The dam will be LOCATED in the: SE 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 6, Township 12 South, Range 10 East, WM, in the County of Jefferson.

The maximum height will be 7.0 feet above the stream bed or ground surface at the centerline. The top width will be 10.0 feet, slope of upstream face 2.5:1, slope of downstream face 1.5:1, and height of dam above water line when full 3.0 feet

The area submerged by the reservoir, when full, will be 3.5 acres, and the maximum depth of water will be 12.0 feet

\* Resources Director to be necessary to satisfy prior downstream rights.

The location and dimensions of the spillway are: Around the dam, the bottom width of the spillway will be 4.0 feet. The top width of the spillway will be 4.0 feet. The distance between the crest of the dam and the crest of the spillway will be 3.0 foot.

The location and dimension of the outlet conduit will be: None.

The structure is in the channel.

The dam will be earthfill construction.

The right hereunder shall be limited to the storage of 12.0 acre-feet

The PRIORITY DATE of this permit is June 22, 1983

Actual construction work shall begin on or before December 28, 1985, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1986
