### PERMIT to CONSTRUCT a RESERVOIR and to STORE for BENEFICIAL USE the PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION **R-68226** and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS AND THE FOLLOWING LIMITATIONS AND CONDITIONS:

This permit is issued to **Jimmy Evans** of 17620 Falls City Road, Dallas, Oregon 97338, phone 787-3662, for the construction of Evans Flashboard Reservoir and storage of water from an unnamed intermittent drainageway, a tributary of Little Luckiamute River to be appropriated under Application 68227, Permit 49147 for irrigation,

The dam will be LOCATED in the: **SE 1/4 SW 1/4** of Section 23, Township 8 South, Range 6 West, WM, in the County of Polk.

The maximum height will be **8.0** feet above the stream bed or ground surface at the centerline. The top width will be **8.0 feet**, slope of upstream face **n/a**, slope of downstream face **n/a**, and height of dam above water line when full **2.0 feet**

The area submerged by the reservoir, when full, will be **0.5 acre**, and the maximum depth of water will be **7.0 feet**

The location and dimensions of the spillway are: **None.**

The location and dimension of the outlet conduit will be: **9 foot overflow in the dam.**

The structure is in the channel.

The dam will have concrete structures with wood flashboards.

The right hereunder shall be limited to the storage of **2.2 acre-feet**

The PRIORITY DATE of this permit is **November 14, 1984.**

Actual construction work shall begin on or before **January 15, 1986**, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 **86**.
