Application for a Permit to Construct a Reservoir and to Store for Beneficial Use the Unappropriated Waters of the State of Oregon

I, L. F. Myers (Name of Applicant)

State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to construct the following described reservoir and to store the unappropriated waters of the State of Oregon, subject to existing rights.

6. The dam will be located in (Smallest legal subdivision), Sec. 1, Tp. 9 S., R. 3 E., W. M. The maximum height will be 6 feet above stream bed or ground surface on center line of dam. The length on top will be 150 feet; length on bottom 150 feet; width on top feet; slope of front or water side 3:1 (Feet horizontal to 1 vertical); slope on back 2:1 (Feet horizontal to 1 vertical); height of dam above water line when full 2 1/2 feet.
