PERMIT to CONSTRUCT a RESERVOIR and to STORE for BENEFICIAL USE the PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION R-66686 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS AND THE FOLLOWING LIMITATIONS AND CONDITIONS:

This permit is issued to United States, Winema National Forest of PO Box 1390, Klamath Falls, Oregon 97601, phone 883-6714, for the construction of Fourbit Flat Reservoir, Choptie N. Reservoir, and Choptie S. Reservoir and storage of water from unnamed streams, tributaries of Sprague River for livestock use, and is subject to the installation and maintenance of an outlet pipe, or to provide other means to*

The dam will be LOCATED in the: A - NW 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 11; B - SW 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 12; C - SE 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 13 all in Township 36 South, Range 8 East, WM, in the County of Klamath.

The maximum height will be n/a feet above the stream bed or ground surface at the centerline. The top width will be n/a, slope of upstream face n/a, slope of downstream face n/a, and height of dam above water line when full n/a

The area submerged by the reservoir, when full, will be ** , and the maximum depth of water will be A - 3.0 feet; B - 4.0 feet; C - 3.0 feet

* evacuate the stored water when determined by the Water Resources Director to be necessary to satisfy prior downstream rights.

** A - 0.037 acre; B - 0.028 acre; C - 0.041 acre

The locations and dimensions of the spillways are: None.

The locations and dimensions of the outlet conduits will be: None.

The dams are in channel.

The dams will be earthfill construction.

The right hereunder shall be limited to the storage of 0.15 acre-foot, being 0.05 af in each reservoir

The PRIORITY DATE of this permit is September 22, 1983

Actual construction work shall begin on or before March 11, 1986, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1986.
