PERMIT to CONSTRUCT a RESERVOIR and to STORE for BENEFICIAL USE the PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION R-68151 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS AND THE FOLLOWING LIMITATIONS AND CONDITIONS:

This permit is issued to Harry G. Spencer of PO Box 291, Langlois, Oregon 97450, phone 347-4114, for the construction of a reservoir and storage of water from Spencer Creek, a tributary to Conner Creek, to be appropriated under Application 68023, Permit 49345 for irrigation and temperature control,

The dam will be LOCATED in the NW 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 13, Township 30 South, Range 15 West, WM, in the County of Coos.

The maximum height will be 9.9 feet above the stream bed or ground surface at the centerline. The top width will be 12.0 feet. Slope of upstream face 2:1, slope of downstream face 2:1, and height of dam above water line when full 1.5 feet.

The area submerged by the reservoir, when full, will be 0.1 acres, and the maximum depth of water will be 10.0 feet.

The dimensions of the spillway are: 12 inch CMP with riser and 18 inch CMP overflow pipe.

The location and dimension of the outlet conduit will be: Buried under surface 18 inch CMP.

The dam is in the channel.

The dam will be earthfill construction.

The right hereunder shall be limited to the storage of 1.0 acre-foot, being 0.8 af for irrigation and 0.2 af for temperature control.

The PRIORITY DATE of this permit is January 31, 1985.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before May 28, 1986, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1987.
