## PERMIT to CONSTRUCT a RESERVOIR and to STORE for BENEFICIAL USE the PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION R-68292 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS AND THE FOLLOWING LIMITATIONS AND CONDITIONS:

This permit is issued to Fred E. Thorburn of PO Box 908, Roseburg, Oregon 97470, phone 827-8041, for the construction of an unnamed reservoir and storage of water from an unnamed intermittent stream, a tributary to Elgarose Creek, to be appropriated under Application 68245, Permit 49355 for irrigation,

The dam will be LOCATED in the: SE 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 28; SW 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 27, both in Township 26 South, Range 7 West, WM, in the County of Douglas.

The maximum height will be 8.0 feet above the stream bed or ground surface at the centerline. The top width will be 10.0 feet, slope of upstream face 3:1, slope of downstream face 2:1, and height of dam above water line when full 2.5 feet.

The area submerged by the reservoir, when full, will be 1.0 acre, and the maximum depth of water will be 5.50 feet.

The dimensions of the spillway are: The bottom width of the spillway will be 8.0 feet. The top width of the spillway will be 12.0 feet. The distance between the crest of the dam and the crest of the spillway will be 2.5 feet.

The location and dimension of the outlet conduit will be: 6 inch asphalt dipped corrugated metal pipe located at the base of the dam.

The dam is in the channel.

The dam will be earthfill construction.

The right hereunder shall be limited to the storage of 5.5 acre-feet

The PRIORITY DATE of this permit is March 4, 1985

Actual construction work shall begin on or before June 7, 1986, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1987.
