**PERMIT to CONSTRUCT a RESERVOIR and to STORE
for BENEFICIAL USE the PUBLIC WATERS**

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION R-68350 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS AND THE FOLLOWING LIMITATIONS AND CONDITIONS:

This permit is issued to Budd L. Shaffer of 8105 Red Prairie Road, Sheridan, Oregon 97378, phone 843-3188, for the construction of the Mohny Reservoir Enlargement and storage of 4.0 acre-feet of water from an unnamed drainage way, a tributary to South Yamhill River, to be appropriated under Application 68351, Permit 49379 for irrigation, and the dam shall be constructed under the supervision of a registered *
The dam will be LOCATED in the: SE 1/4 NW 1/4, Section 15, Township 6 South, Range 6 West, WM, in the County of Polk.

The maximum height will be 15.4 feet above the stream bed or ground surface at the centerline. The top width will be 8.0 feet, slope of upstream face 3:1, slope of downstream face 2:1, and height of dam above water line when full 3.7 feet

The area submerged by the reservoir, when full, will be 2.8 acres, and the maximum depth of water will be 11.7 feet

The dimensions of the spillway are: The bottom width of the spillway will be 50.0 feet. The top width of the spillway will be 62.0 feet. The distance between the crest of the dam and the crest of the spillway will be 3.2 feet.

The location and dimension of the outlet conduit will be: A 36 inch riser, 24 inch outlet conduit.

The dam is in the channel.

The dam will be earthfill construction.

The right hereunder shall be limited to the storage of 4.0 acre-feet

The PRIORITY DATE of this permit is May 15, 1985

Actual construction work shall begin on or before July 2, 1986, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1987.
