PERMIT to CONSTRUCT a RESERVOIR and to STORE for BENEFICIAL USE the PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION R-68473 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS AND THE FOLLOWING LIMITATIONS AND CONDITIONS:

This permit is issued to David W. Horner of Route 1, Box 328, Forest Grove, Oregon 97116, phone 357-3259, for the construction of an excavated sump reservoir and storage of water from south drain ditch with any deficiency in supply from south drain ditch to be made up by appropriation of water from the north drain, a tributaries of Dairy Creek, to be maintained and appropriated under Application 68534, Permit 49461, for *
The dam will be LOCATED in the: SE 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 9, Township 1 North, Range 4 West, WM, in the County of Washington.

The maximum height will be n/a feet above the stream bed or ground surface at the centerline. The top width will be n/a, slope of upstream face n/a, slope of downstream face n/a, and height of dam above water line when full n/a

The area submerged by the reservoir, when full, will be 1.64 acres, and the maximum depth of water will be 16.0 feet

* recreation and irrigation,

The dimensions of the spillway are: None; Control inlet.

The location and dimension of the outlet conduit will be: None.

The dam is out of the channel.

The dam will be an excavated sump.

The right hereunder shall be limited to the storage of 25.0 acre-feet, being 1.0 acre-foot for recreation and 24.0 acre-feet for irrigation

The PRIORITY DATE of this permit is August 12, 1985.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before October 21, 1986, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1987.
