PERMIT to CONSTRUCT a RESERVOIR and to STORE for BENEFICIAL USE the PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION R-68606 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS AND THE FOLLOWING LIMITATIONS AND CONDITIONS:

This permit is issued to Carl A. Gerlinger of 3791 Augusta National Drive, S., Salem, Oregon 97302, phone 585-2025, for the construction of four duck lakes and storage of water from North Fork Ash Creek, a tributary of Willamette River, to be maintained by appropriation of water under Application 68607, Permit 49563 for duck attraction,

The dam will be LOCATED in the: 1 - NW 1/4 NE 1/4; 2 - NE 1/4 NE 1/4; 3 - SW 1/4 NE 1/4; 4 - SE 1/4 NE 1/4, all of Section 3, Township 8 South, Range 5 West, WM, in the County of Polk.

The maximum height will be 2.0 feet above the stream bed or ground surface at the centerline. The top width will be 6.0, slope of upstream face 3:1, slope of downstream face 3:1, and height of dam above water line when full n/a

The area submerged by the reservoir, when full, will be 9.0 acres, and the maximum depth of water will be 20 inches

* stored annually during the nonirrigation season or when excess water is otherwise available.

The dimensions of the spillway are: None.

The location and dimension of the outlet conduit will be: None.

The dam is out of the channel.

The four shallow duck lakes on applicants property are connected by shallow ponds with small berm to back up water. Flow controlled from one pond to another is by small pipe through berms with head gate.

The right hereunder shall be limited to the storage of 25.0 acre-feet, being 8.0 af in Duck Lake 1, 8.0 af in Duck Lake 2, 4.5 af in Duck Lake 3, and 4.5 af in Duck Lake 4, to be *
The PRIORITY DATE of this permit is November 1, 1985.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before December 16, 1986, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1987.
