PERMIT to CONSTRUCT a RESERVOIR and to STORE for BENEFICIAL USE the PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION R-68561 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS AND THE FOLLOWING LIMITATIONS AND CONDITIONS:

This permit is issued to Lake Oswego Corporation, an Oregon Corporation of 700 SW McVey Avenue, Lake Oswego, Oregon 97034, phone 636-1422, for the construction of Lake Oswego Reservoir and storage of water from the Tualatin River to be maintained by appropriation under Application 68562, Permit 49575 for recreation,

The dam will be LOCATED in the: ⁵³⁻¹⁻²⁻²⁻¹ NW 1/4 SE 1/4, Section 10, Township 2 South, Range 1 East, WM, in the County of Clackamas.

The maximum height will be 32.0 feet above the stream bed or ground surface at the centerline. The top width will be 5.0, slope of upstream face vertical, slope of downstream face 3:1, and height of dam above water line when full 5.0 feet

The area submerged by the reservoir, when full, will be 400 acres, and the maximum depth of water will be 55-60 feet

The dimensions of the spillway are: The bottom width of the spillway will be 48.0 feet. The top width of the spillway will be 48.0 feet. The distance between the crest of the dam and the crest of the spillway will be 8.0 feet.

The location and dimension of the outlet conduit will be: Existing 5 foot diameter pipeline for hydro project; 150 foot wide weir for flood control, empties into 10 foot x 15 foot spillway; 60 foot wide flood control device with 36 removeable 8 foot "stop-logs."

The dam is out of the channel.

The dam will be concrete construction.

The right hereunder shall be limited to the storage of 9800 acre-feet annually during the nonirrigation season or when excess water is otherwise available.

The PRIORITY DATE of this permit is September 24, 1985

Actual construction work shall begin on or before March 7, 1987, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 87.
