PERMIT to CONSTRUCT a RESERVOIR and to STORE for BENEFICIAL USE the PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION R-68593 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS AND THE FOLLOWING LIMITATIONS AND CONDITIONS:

This permit is issued to Dan R. Shugart of 4280 South Fork Little Butte Creek Road, Eagle Point, Oregon 97524, phone 826-2376, for the construction of Shugart Reservoir and storage of water from an unnamed stream, a tributary of South Fork Little Butte Creek for stockwater,

The dam will be LOCATED in the SW 1/4 NE 1/4, Section 33, Township 36 South, Range 2 East, WM, in the County of Jackson.

The maximum height will be 9.6 feet above the stream bed or ground surface at the centerline. The top width will be 15.0 feet, slope of upstream face 3:1, slope of downstream face 2:1, and height of dam above water line when full 3.0 feet.

The area submerged by the reservoir, when full, will be 1.0 acre, and the maximum depth of water will be 12.0 feet.

The dimensions of the spillway are: The bottom width of the spillway will be 12.0 feet. The top width of the spillway will be 20.0 feet. The distance between the crest of the dam and the crest of the spillway will be 3.0 feet.

The location and dimension of the outlet conduit will be: Near center of dam, 10 feet below top, 12 inches schedule 80 PVC with 12 inch gate valve.

The dam is out of the channel.

The dam will be earthfill construction.

The right hereunder shall be limited to the storage of 9.0 acre-feet annually during the nonirrigation season or when excess water is otherwise available.

The PRIORITY DATE of this permit is October 21, 1985.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before March 21, 1987, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1987.
