PERMIT to CONSTRUCT a RESERVOIR and to STORE for BENEFICIAL USE the PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION R-65249 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS AND THE FOLLOWING LIMITATIONS AND CONDITIONS:

This permit is issued to Phillip Murphy of Box 114, Monument, Oregon, 97864, phone 934-2421, for the construction of a reservoir and storage of water from an unnamed draw supplemented by water from Dry Creek, tributaries of North Fork John Day River, to be appropriated under Application 65245, Permit 49608, for supplemental irrigation.*

The dam will be LOCATED in the: NE 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 11, Township 9 South, Range 27 East, WM, in the County of Grant.

The maximum height will be 9.9 feet above the stream bed or ground surface at the centerline. The top width will be 12.0 feet , slope of downstream face 2:1 , and height of dam above water line when full 2.5 feet

The area submerged by the reservoir, when full, will be 2.5 acres , and the maximum depth of water will be 10.0 feet

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The right hereunder shall be limited to the storage of 9.2 acre-feet annually during the nonirrigation season or when excess water is otherwise available.

The PRIORITY DATE of this permit is November 29, 1984

Actual construction work shall begin on or before May 9, 1987 diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 88.
