PERMIT to CONSTRUCT a RESERVOIR and to STORE for BENEFICIAL USE the PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION R-68580 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS AND THE FOLLOWING LIMITATIONS AND CONDITIONS:

This permit is issued to Clarence E. Green of Route 1, Box 27, Baker, Oregon, 97814, phone 523-2006, for the construction of Green Reservoir and storage of water from Washington Gulch Creek, a tributary of Powder River, to be maintained by appropriation under Application 68625, Permit 49646 for fish culture.

The dam will be LOCATED in the: SW 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 11, Township 9 South, Range 39 East, WM, in the County of Baker.

The maximum height will be 9.5 feet above the stream bed or ground surface at the centerline. The top width will be 21.0 feet, slope of upstream face 3:1, slope of downstream face 10':9.5, and height of dam above water line when full 3.5 feet

The area submerged by the reservoir, when full, will be 8.0/10.0 acres, and the maximum depth of water will be 11.0 feet. The dimensions of the spillway are: The bottom width of the spillway will be --- feet. The top width of the spillway will be --- feet. The distance between the crest of the dam and the crest of the spillway will be --- feet. Spillway is a 30 inch culvert through dam.

The location and dimension of the outlet conduit will be: Screened outlet 9.0 feet below top of dam to 8 inch pipe to pump and 8 inch outlet to streambed.

The dam is out of the channel.

The dam will be earthfill construction.

The right hereunder shall be limited to the storage of 6.5 acre-feet annually during the nonirrigation season or when excess water is otherwise available.
The PRIORITY DATE of this permit is September 27, 1985

Actual construction work shall begin on or before June 30, 1987, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 88 .
