This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION R-63233 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS AND THE FOLLOWING LIMITATIONS AND CONDITIONS:

Dlaylock of Riverside, Cregon, 97917, phone 493-2461, for This permit is issued to of Reservoir #3 and storage of water from unnamed stream #2; Stream #2 to be supplemented by water from the South Fork Malbeur River and construction of Reservoir #4 and storage of water from unnamed stream #1; to be supplemented by water from the South Fork Malbeur River, tributaries of Malbeur River all to be ap-*

Reservoir #3- SE 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 20; Reservoir #4The dam will be 104 Section 20, both in Township 24 South, Range 37 East, WM, in the County of Malbeur. #3-23

The maximum height will be #4-15 feet above the stream bed or ground surface at the centerline. The top width will both be 10.0 feet, slope of upstream face 3.1, slope of downstream face 2.1, and height of dam above water

The area submerged by the reservoir, when full, will b $\frac{3-4.8}{4-2.8}$ acres and the maximum depth of water will be $\frac{3-20.6}{4-12.6}$ feet

The dimensions of the spillways are: The bottom width of the spillway will be both-8.0 feet. The top width of the spillway will be both-20.0 feet. The distance between the crest of the dam and the crest of the spillway will be both-3.25 feet.

The locations and dimensions of the outlet conduits will be: Both-& inch pipes located under reservoirs in center of drainage.

The dams are out of the channel.

The dam will be earthfill construction.
