PERMIT to CONSTRUCT a RESERVOIR and to STORE for BENEFICIAL USE the PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION R-68734 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS AND THE FOLLOWING LIMITATIONS AND CONDITIONS:

This permit is issued to Gary G. Bliss, P.E. of 11080 SW Allen Boulevard, Suite 100, Beaverton, Oregon, 97005, phone 643-9410, for the construction of two Jenne Lake Reservoirs and storage of water from an unnamed stream, a tributary of Willow Creek, to be maintained by appropriation under Application 68735, Permit 49676 for recreational uses including aesthetics, fish and fowl habitat.

The dam will be LOCATED in the: SW 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 32, Township 1 North, Range 1 West, WM, in the County of Washington.

Both will be

The maximum height will be 6.0 feet above the stream bed or ground surface at the centerline. The top width will be 10.0 feet, slope of upstream face 3:1, slope of downstream face 3:1, and height of dam above water line when full 0.5 feet

The area submerged by the reservoir, when full, will be * acres, and the maximum depth of water will be ** feet

* Lower reservoir- 4.5 acre-feet

** Upper reservoir- 3.6 acre-feet

The dimensions of the spillways are: The bottom width of the spillways will be 13.5 feet. The top width of the spillways will be 17.7 feet. The distance between the crest of the dam and the crest of the spillways will be 1.4 feet.

The location and dimension of the outlet conduit will be: Concrete grouted weir section.

The dam is out of the channel.

The dam will be a combination of earthfill, rock riprap and concrete construction.

The right hereunder shall be limited to the storage of 8.1 acre-feet annually during the nonirrigation season or when excess water is otherwise available.

The PRIORITY DATE of this permit is May 23, 1986.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before July 17, 1987, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1988.
