PERMIT to CONSTRUCT a RESERVOIR and to STORE for BENEFICIAL USE the PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION R-67820 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS AND THE FOLLOWING LIMITATIONS AND CONDITIONS:

This permit is issued to Bureau of Land Management of P.O. Box 700, Vale, Oregon 97918, phone 475-3144, for the construction of Oxbow (0677) Reservoir and storage of water from an unnamed tributary of the Owyhee River for livestock and wildlife, and is subject to the installation and maintenance of an outlet pipe, or to provide other means to evacuate the stored water when determined*

The dam will be LOCATED in the: SE 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 21, Township 22 South, Range 44 East, W4, in the County of Malheur.

The maximum height will be 13.0 feet above the stream bed or ground surface at the centerline. The top width will be 8.0 feet, slope of upstream face 6:1, slope of downstream face 2 1/2:1, and height of dam above water line when full 2.5 feet.

The area submerged by the reservoir, when full, will be 0.3 acres, and the maximum depth of water will be 7.0 feet

The dimensions of the spillway are: The bottom width of the spillway will be 6 feet. The top width of the spillway will be 20 feet. The distance between the crest of the dam and the crest of the spillway will be 2.5 feet.

The location and dimensions of the outlet conduit will be: none.

The dam is in the channel.

The dam will be earthfill construction.

* by the Water Resources Director to be necessary to satisfy prior downstream rights.

The right hereunder shall be limited to the storage of 0.8 acre-feet annually during the nonirrigation season or when excess water is otherwise available.

The PRIORITY DATE of this permit is October 14, 1983

Actual construction work shall begin on or before July 29, 1987, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1988.
