## PERMIT to CONSTRUCT a RESERVOIR and to STORE for BENEFICIAL USE the PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION R-67877 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS AND THE FOLLOWING LIMITATIONS AND CONDITIONS:

This permit is issued to Bureau of Land Management of P.O. Box 700, Vale, Oregon 97918, phone 473-3144, for the construction of Schweizer (0445) Reservoir and storage of water from an unnamed intermittent tributary of the Malheur River for livestock and wildlife, and is subject to the installation and maintenance of an outlet pipe or other means of evacuating the stored water when\*

The dam will be LOCATED in the NE 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 8, Township 22 South, Range 44 East, WM, in the County of Malheur.

The maximum height will be 18.7 feet above the stream bed or ground surface at the centerline. The top width will be 14.0 feet. slope of upstream face 5:1, slope of downstream face 2 1/2:1, and height of dam above water line when full 4.7 feet.

The area submerged by the reservoir, when full, will be 1.1 acres, and the maximum depth of water will be 9.0 feet

The dimensions of the spillway are: The bottom width of the spillway will be 13 feet. The top width of the spillway will be 30 feet. The distance between the crest of the dam and the crest of the spillway will be 4.7 feet.

The location and dimensions of the outlet conduit will be: none.

The dam is in the channel.

The dam will be earthfill construction.

\* determined by the Water Resources Director to be necessary to satisfy prior downstream rights.

The right hereunder shall be limited to the storage of 4.0 acre-feet annually during the nonirrigation season or when excess water is otherwise available.

The PRIORITY DATE of this permit is October 14, 1983.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before August 7, 1987, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1988.
