PERMIT to CONSTRUCT a RESERVOIR and to STORE for BENEFICIAL USE the PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION R-68755 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS AND THE FOLLOWING LIMITATIONS AND CONDITIONS:

This permit is issued to Jean Kessel of 6100 NE Mineral Spring Road, Carlton, Oregon, 97111, phone 862-7468, for the construction of a reservoir and storage of water from an unnamed stream, a tributary of Hawn Creek, to be maintained by appropriation under Application 68756, Permit 49708, for recreation.

The dam will be LOCATED in the: SE 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 35, Township 3 South, Range 4 West, WM, in the County of Yamhill.

The maximum height will be ____ feet above the stream bed or ground surface at the centerline. The top width will be ____ , slope of upstream face ____ , slope of downstream face ____ , and height of dam above water line when full ____

The area submerged by the reservoir, when full, will be 0.16 acres, and the maximum depth of water will be 6.0 feet

The location and dimension of the outlet conduit will be: None.

The reservoir is out of the channel.

The reservoir will be excavated below ground level with the following dimensions: Length- 100.0 feet; Width- 70.0 feet; Depth- 6.0 feet; Side slopes- 2:1.

The right hereunder shall be limited to the storage of 0.7 acre-foot annually during the nonirrigation season or when excess water is otherwise available.

The PRIORITY DATE of this permit is June 12, 1986

Actual construction work shall begin on or before August 28, 1987, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19, 88.
