PERMIT to CONSTRUCT a RESERVOIR and to STORE for BENEFICIAL USE the PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION R-66977 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS AND THE FOLLOWING LIMITATIONS AND CONDITIONS:

This permit is issued to Bureau of Land Management of 74 S. Alvord, Burns, Oregon 97720, phone 573-2071, for the construction of Surprise Seep (4351) Reservoir and storage of water from an unnamed tributary of Canyon Creek for livestock and wildlife, and is subject to the installation and maintenance of an outlet pipe or other means of evacuating the stored water when determined by the Water*
The dam will be LOCATED in the: NE1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 1, Township 14 South, Range 31 East, WM, in the County of Grant.

The maximum height will be 3.0 feet above the stream bed or ground surface at the centerline. The top width will be 3.0 feet slope of upstream face 3:1, slope of downstream face 2:1, and height of dam above water line when full 1.5 feet.

The area submerged by the reservoir, when full, will be 0.25 acres, and the maximum depth of water will be 1.5 feet

The dimensions of the spillway are: The bottom width of the spillway will be 2.5 feet. The top width of the spillway will be 12 feet. The distance between the crest of the dam and the crest of the spillway will be 1.5 feet.

The location and dimensions of the outlet conduit will be: none.

The dam is in the channel.

The dam will be earthfill construction.

* Resources Director to be necessary to satisfy prior downstream rights.

The right hereunder shall be limited to the storage of 0.375 acre-feet annually during the nonirrigation season or when excess water is otherwise available.

The PRIORITY DATE of this permit is September 30, 1983

Actual construction work shall begin on or before August 28, 1987, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1988.
