PERMIT to CONSTRUCT a RESERVOIR and to STORE for BENEFICIAL USE the PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION **R-65997** and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS AND THE FOLLOWING LIMITATIONS AND CONDITIONS:

This permit is issued to **Bureau of Land Management of P. O. Box 151, Lakeview, Oregon 97630, phone 947-2177,** for the construction of **Wopfolly Waterhole (4690) Reservoir** and storage of water from an unnamed tributary of **Pitchlog Creek** for livestock and wildlife, and is subject to the installation and maintenance of an outlet pipe or other means of evacuating the stored water when*
The dam will be LOCATED in the: **NW1/4 NW1/4 of Section 8, Township 40 South, Range 15 East, WM,** in the County of **Klamath.**

The maximum height will be **-** feet above the stream bed or ground surface at the centerline. The top width will be **-**, slope of upstream face **-**, slope of downstream face **-**, and height of dam above water line when full **-**

The area submerged by the reservoir, when full, will be **0.2 acres**, and the maximum depth of water will be **4.0 feet**

The dimensions of the spillway are: **No spillway. Water bypasses waterhole when full.**

The location and dimensions of the outlet conduit will be: **none.**

The dam is out of the channel.

The dam will be an excavated pit-type waterhole.

* determined by the Water Resources Director to be necessary to satisfy prior downstream rights.

The right hereunder shall be limited to the storage of **0.4 acre-foot** annually during the nonirrigation season or when excess water is otherwise available.

The PRIORITY DATE of this permit is **September 9, 1983**

Actual construction work shall begin on or before **August 28, 1987**, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before **October 1, 1988**.
