## PERMIT to CONSTRUCT a RESERVOIR and to STORE for BENEFICIAL USE the PUBLIC WATERS

R-65997 This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS AND THE FOLLOWING LIMITATIONS AND CONDITIONS:

Bureau of Land Management of P. O. Box 151, Lakeview, This permit is issued to 947-2177, for the construction of Wopfolly Waterhole (4690) Reservoir and storage of water from an unnamed tributary of Pitchlog Creek for livestock and wildlife, and is subject to the installation and maintenance of an outlet pipe or other means of evacuating the stored water when\* The dam will be LOCATED in the: NW1/4 NW1/4 of Section 8, Township 40 South, Range 15 East, WM, in the County of Klamath.

The maximum height will be feet above the stream bed or ground surface at the centerline. The top width will , slope of upstream face be , slope of downstream face , and height of dam above water line when full

The dimensions of the spillway are: No spillway. Water bypasses waterhole when full.

The right hereunder shall be limited to the storage of 0.4 acre-foot the nonirrigation season or when excess water is otherwise available. The PRIORITY DATE of this permit is September 9, 1983
