PERMIT to CONSTRUCT a RESERVOIR and to STORE for BENEFICIAL USE the PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION R-68771 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS AND THE FOLLOWING LIMITATIONS AND CONDITIONS:

This permit is issued to James R. Marr of 14995 Ferns Corner Road, Monmouth, Oregon, 97361, phone 838-2727, for the construction of Marr Reservoir and storage of water from an unnamed drainage way, a tributary of Luckiamute River for livestock.

The dam will be LOCATED in the: SW 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 29, Township 8 South, Range 5 West, WM, in the County of Polk.

The maximum height will be 9.5 feet above the stream bed or ground surface at the centerline. The top width will be 10.0 feet, slope of upstream face 3:1, slope of downstream face 2:1, and height of dam above water line when full 2.8 feet

The area submerged by the reservoir, when full, will be 0.6 acres, and the maximum depth of water will be 12.0 feet

The dimensions of the spillway are: The bottom width of the spillway will be 12.0 feet. The top width of the spillway will be 18.0 feet. The distance between the crest of the dam and the crest of the spillway will be 2.5 feet.

The location and dimension of the outlet conduit will be: 6 inch under center of the dam with a 12 inch trickle tube and a 4 inch outlet valve.

The dam is in the channel.

The dam will be earthfill construction.

The right hereunder shall be limited to the storage of 2.3 acre-foot annually during the nonirrigation season or when excess water is otherwise available. The PRIORITY DATE of this permit is June 26, 1986.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before September 17, 1987, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1988.
