## PERMIT to CONSTRUCT a RESERVOIR and to STORE for BENEFICIAL USE the PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION R-68825 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS AND THE FOLLOWING LIMITATIONS AND CONDITIONS:

This permit is issued to William Jarvis of 27175 SW Frys Lane, Sheridan, Oregon, 97378, phone 843-4984, for the construction of a reservoir and storage of water from an unnamed drainageway, a tributary of Salt Creek, for livestock water and is subject to the installation and maintenance of an outlet pipe, or to provide other means to evacuate the stored water when determined by the Water Resources Director to be \*
The dam will be LOCATED in the: SW 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 2, Township 6 South, Range 6 West, WM, in the County of Polk.

The maximum height will be 9.5 feet above the stream bed or ground surface at the centerline. The top width will be 12.0 feet , slope of upstream face 4:1 , slope of downstream face 3:1 , and height of dam above water line when full 3.0 feet

The area submerged by the reservoir, when full, will be 0.5 acres, and the maximum depth of water will be 11.0 feet.

The dimensions of the spillway are: The top width of the spillway will be 16.0 feet (natural swale). The distance between the crest of the dam and the crest of the spillway will be 3.0 feet.

The location and dimension of the outlet conduit will be: None.

The dam is in the channel.

The dam will be earthfill construction.

\* necessary to satisfy prior downstream rights.

The right hereunder shall be limited to the storage of 2.5 acre-feet annually during the nonirrigation season or when excess water is otherwise available.

The PRIORITY DATE of this permit is August 14, 1986.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before December 22, 1987, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 88 • Extended to October 1, 1989
