PERMIT to CONSTRUCT a RESERVOTR and to STORE for BENEFICIAL USE the PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION R-69035 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS AND THE FOLLOWING LIMITATIONS AND CONDITIONS:

This permit is issued to Susan McAuliffe of P.O. Box 456, Fort Klamath, Oregon 97626, phone 381-2294; Sally Lyons Fitzgerald of P.O. Box 7, Plush, Oregon 97639, phone 947-4349; Western Bank, Trustee of P.O. Box 1225, Coos Bay, Oregon 97420, phone 269-5171, for the construction of two reservoirs, being Reservoir #1 and storage of water from *

The dam will be LOCATED in the: Both dams being within SE 1/4 SE 1/4, Section 23, Township 26 South, Range 13 West, WM, in the County of Coos.

The maximum height will be ** feet above the stream bed or ground surface at the centerline. The top width will be *** , slope of downstream face 2:1 , and height of dam above water line when full 3.0 feet.

The dimensions of the spillways are: The bottom width of the spillways will be 2.0 feet. The top width of the spillways will be 4.5 feet. The distance between the crest of the dams and the crest of the spillways will be 2.5 feet.

The dams are in the channels.

The dams will be earthfill construction.

The right hereunder shall be limited to the storage of 1.04 acre-feet, being 0.73 af in Reservoir #1 and 0.31 af in Reservoir #2, annually during the nonirrigation season or when***** The PRIORITY DATE of this permit is March 23, 1987.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before July 24, 1988, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19, 89.
