### PERMIT to CONSTRUCT a RESERVOIR and to STORE for BENEFICIAL USE the PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION R-69003 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS AND THE FOLLOWING LIMITATIONS AND CONDITIONS:

This permit is issued to Associated Fruit Company of PO Box 4429, Medford, Oregon 97501, phone 535-1787, for the construction of the El Roble Orchard Reservoir and storage of water from South Fork Little Butte Creek with any deficiency in the available supply from South Fork Little Butte Creek to be made up by appropriation from North Fork Little Butte Creek to be appropriated under Application 69004, Permit 50021, for\*  
The dam will be LOCATED in the: NE 1/4 NW 1/4, Section 33, Township 37 South, Range 2 West, WM, in the County of Jackson.

The maximum height will be 9.8 feet above the stream bed or ground surface at the centerline. The top width will be 10.0 feet, slope of upstream face 3:1, slope of downstream face 2:1, and height of dam above water line when full 2.5 feet.

The area submerged by the reservoir, when full, will be 1.0 acre, and the maximum depth of water will be 14.0 feet.

The dimensions of the spillway are: The bottom width of the spillway will be 8.0 feet. The top width of the spillway will be 14.0 feet. The distance between the crest of the dam and the crest of the spillway will be 3.0 feet.

The location and dimension of the outlet conduit will be: 6.0 feet.

The dam is not in the channel.

The dam will be earthfill construction.

\* temperature control.

The right hereunder shall be limited to the storage of 9.0 acre-feet annually during the nonirrigation season or when excess water is otherwise available.  
The PRIORITY DATE of this permit is January 28, 1987.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before August 18, 1988, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1989.
