PERMIT to CONSTRUCT a RESERVOIR and to STORE for BENEFICIAL USE the PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION R=69080 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS AND THE FOLLOWING LIMITATIONS AND CONDITIONS:

This permit is issued to John Good of 17394 Alsea Highway, Tidewater, Oregon 97390, phone 528–3838, for the construction of private property reservoir and storage of water from an unnamed stream to be appropriated under Application 69081, Permit 50037, for irrigation.

The dam will be LOCATED in the: SW 1/4 SW 1/4, Section 6, Township 14 South, Range 9 West, WM, in the County of Lincoln.

The maximum height will be 9.0 feet above the stream bed or ground surface at the centerline. The top width will be 26.0 feet , slope of upstream face 3:1 , slope of downstream face 2:1 , and height of dam above water line when full 1.0 feet.

The area submerged by the reservoir, when full, will be *

, and the maximum depth of water will be

* less than 0.05 acre

** less than 8.0 feet.

The dimensions of the spillway are: The bottom width of the spillway will be 4.0 feet. The top width of the spillway will be 4.0 feet.

The location and dimension of the outlet conduit will be: Center of stream, center and base of dam. Inlet at toe of upstream gradient. Outlet at heel of downstream gradient. Conduit size will be not less than 4 inches nor more than 6 inches.

The dam is in the channel.

The dam will be of concrete construction with center flashboards. Upstream and downstream gradient of dam will utilize composite rock.

All flashboards to be removed from spillway during the period from October 1 to April 1 of each year.

The right hereunder shall be limited to the storage of 0.082 acre-foot annually during the nonirrigation season or when excess water is otherwise available.

The PRIORITY DATE of this permit is May 5, 1987 .

Actual construction work shall begin on or before August 18, 1988, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19
