Application for a Permit to Construct a Reservoir and to Store for Beneficial Use the Unappropriated Waters of the State of Oregon

I, Domes Turkey Farm (Name of Applicant)

State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to construct the following described reservoir and to store the unappropriated waters of the State of Oregon, subject to existing rights.

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

1. The name of the proposed reservoir is two reservoirs

2. The name of the stream from which the reservoir is to be filled and the appropriation made is an unnamed stream, trib. Ash Swale tributary of Salt Creek, trib. South Yamhill River

3. The amount of water to be stored is 9.6 acre feet.

4. The use to be made of the impounded water is irrigation (Irrigation, power, domestic supply, etc.)

5. The location of the proposed reservoir will be in Sec. 20 (Give sections or townships to be submerged) Tp. 6 S., R. 4 W., W. M., in the county of Polk

6. The dam will be located in NE 1/4 NE 1/4 NE 1/4 NW 1/4, Sec. 20, Tp. 6 S., R. 4 W., W. M. The maximum height will be 8 - (west) 7 - (east) feet above stream bed or ground surface on center line of dam. The length on top will be 30 210 feet; length on bottom 30 210 feet; width on top 20 8 feet; slope of front or water side 3:1 (Feet horizontal to 1 vertical); slope on back 3:1 (Feet horizontal to 1 vertical); height of dam above water line when full both 2 1/2 feet.
