PERMIT to CONSTRUCT a RESERVOIR and to STORE for BENEFICIAL USE the PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION R-68800 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS AND THE FOLLOWING LIMITATIONS AND CONDITIONS:

This permit is issued to Bureau of Land Management of 777 Garden Valley Blvd., Roseburg, Oregon 97470, phone 672-4491, for the construction of the Turquious Springs Reservoir and storage of water from an unnamed tributary of Tenmile Creek to be appropriated under Application 68802, Permit 50089 for fire control of slash burning on Bureau of Land Management lands.

The dam will be LOCATED in the: SW1/4 NW1/4 of Section 21, Township 28 South, Range 8 West, W.M., in the County of Douglas.

The maximum height will be 15.0 feet above the stream bed or ground surface at the centerline. The top width will be 18.0 feet, slope of upstream face 2:1, slope of downstream face 2:1, and height of dam above water line when full 3.0 feet

The area submerged by the reservoir, when full, will be 0.2 acre, and the maximum depth of water will be 13.0 feet

The dimensions of the spillway are: The bottom width of the spillway will be 3.0 feet. The top width will be 8.0 feet. The distance between the crest of the dam and the crest of the spillway will be 2.8 feet.

The location and dimensions of the outlet conduit will be: Through dam; 42 inch and 24 inch CM pipe.

The dam is out of the channel.

The dam will be earthfill construction.

The right hereunder shall be limited to the storage of 1.6 acre-foot annually during the nonirrigation season or when excess water is otherwise available.

The PRIORITY DATE of this permit is July 23, 1986

Actual construction work shall begin on or before October 30, 1988, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1989.
