PERMIT to CONSTRUCT a RESERVOIR and to STORE for BENEFICIAL USE the PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION R-69245 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS AND THE FOLLOWING LIMITATIONS AND CONDITIONS:

This permit is issued to Lyle Schmidt of 1320 Fir Villa Road, Dallas, Oregon 97338, for the construction of Schmidt Reservoir and storage of water from an unnamed intermittent tributary of Rickreall Creek for stock water,

The dam will be LOCATED in the: NW1/4 NW1/4 of Section 23, Township 7 South, Range 5 West, W.M., in the County of Polk.

The maximum height will be 9.0 feet above the stream bed or ground surface at the centerline. The top width will be 12.0 feet, slope of upstream face 3:1, slope of downstream face 2:1, and height of dam above water line when full 2.5 feet

The area submerged by the reservoir, when full, will be 0.4 acre, and the maximum depth of water will be 12.0 feet

The location and dimensions of the spillway are: Around North abutment; the bottom width will be 12.0 feet and the top width will be 18.0 feet. The distance between the crest of the dam and the crest of the spillway will be 2.5 feet.

The location and dimensions of the outlet conduit will be: 12 inch trickle tube with 6 inch conduit and 4 inch valve through the center of the dam.

The dam will be in the channel.

The dam will be earthfill construction.

The right hereunder shall be limited to the storage of 1.2 acre-feet annually during the nonirrigation season or when excess water is otherwise available.

The PRIORITY DATE of this permit is August 21, 1987.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before December 31, 1988, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1989.
