PERMIT to CONSTRUCT a RESERVOIR and to STORE for BENEFICIAL USE the PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION R-69278 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS AND THE FOLLOWING LIMITATIONS AND CONDITIONS:

This permit is issued to George D. and Claire T. Rives of 35900 N.E. Willsonville Road, Newberg, Oregon 97132, phone 625-7367, for the construction of an unnamed reservoir and storage of water from an unnamed swale to be appropriated under Application 69279, Permit 50198, for recreational uses, to include fish, wildlife attraction and aesthetics,

The dam will be LOCATED in the: SE1/4 NE1/4 of Section 1, Township 4 South, Range 2 West, W.M., in the County of Yamhill.

The maximum height will be - feet above the stream bed or ground surface at the centerline. The top width will be - , slope of upstream face - , slope of downstream face - , and height of dam above water line when full -

The area submerged by the reservoir, when full, will be 0.31 acre , and the maximum depth of water will be 6.0 feet

The reservoir will be an excavated pit.

There will be no spillway.

The location and dimensions of the outlet conduit will be: none.

The dam will be in the channel.

The right hereunder shall be limited to the storage of 0.75 acre-foot annually during the nonirrigation season or when excess water is otherwise available.

The PRIORITY DATE of this permit is September 3, 1987.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before March 30, 1989 , and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1989 .
