PERMIT to CONSTRUCT a RESERVOIR and to STORE for BENEFICIAL USE the PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION R-69568 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS AND THE FOLLOWING LIMITATIONS AND CONDITIONS:

This permit is issued to Robert W. Darm, President, Yamhill County Mushrooms, of 7246 Lilac Hill Road, Yamhill, Oregon 97148, phone 662-4131, for the construction of an unnamed reservoir and storage of water from an unnamed drainageway to be appropriated under Application 69569, Permit 50219 for mushroom farming.

The dam will be LOCATED in the: NE 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 28, Township 2 South, Range 4 West, WM, in the County of Yamhill.

The maximum height will be 8.75 feet above the stream bed or ground surface at the centerline. The top width will be 8.0 feet, slope of upstream face 2:1, slope of downstream face 2:1, and height of dam above water line when full 1.75 feet.

The area submerged by the reservoir, when full, will be 1.5 acres, and the maximum depth of water will be 7.0 feet.

The location and dimension of the outlet conduit will be: 12 inch gate valve located at the Southwest Corner of the pond.

The dam is out of the channel.

The dam will be an earthfill construction.

The right hereunder shall be limited to the storage of 9.0 acre-feet annually during the nonirrigation season or when excess water is otherwise available.

The PRIORITY DATE of this permit is March 28, 1988.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before May 25, 1989, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1990.
