The permit to store these waters is granted under Reservoir Application R-69447 with a date of priority of NOVEMBER 3, 1987. The amount of water entitled to be stored each year under such right for the purposes aforesaid, shall not exceed 4.20 acre-feet.

The dam will be located in the:

SW 1/4 NW 1/4, Section 10, T 04 S, R 02 W, WM;

The maximum height will be 2.40 feet above the stream bed or ground surface at the centerline. The top width will be 13.0 feet, slope of upstream face vertical, slope of downstream face vertical, and height of dam above water line when full 0.0 foot. The area submerged by the reservoir, when full, will be 2.80 acres and the maximum depth of water will be 2.4 feet.

1/41/4 SECTION TOWNSHIP RANGE, WM WILDLIFE SW NW 10 04 S 02 W

Actual construction work shall begin on or before July 12, 1989 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1,1990.

This permit is for the beneficial use of water. By law, the land use associated with this water use must be in compliance with statewide land-use goals and any local acknowledged land-use plan. It is possible that the land use you propose may not be allowed if it is not in keeping with the goals and the acknowledged plan. Your city or county planning agency can advise you about the land-use plan in your area.
