is hereby issued a permit to construct Waldon Pond and storage of waters from AN UNNAMED STREAM, A TRIBUTARY OF CHEHALEM CREEK, TO BE MAINTAINED BY APPROPRIATION OF WATER FROM THE UNNAMED STREAM UNDER APPLICATION 69618, PERMIT 50258, FOR RECREATION.

The permit to store these waters is granted under Reservoir Application R-69617 with a date of priority of MAY 19, 1988. The amount of water entitled to be stored each year under such right, for the purposes aforesaid, shall not exceed 36.0 ACRE-FEET.

The dam will be located in the:

NE 1/4 SW 1/4 & NW 1/4 SE 1/4, Section 10, T 3 S, R 3 W, WM.

The maximum height will be 8.00 feet above the stream bed or ground surface at the centerline. The top width will be 10.0 feet, slope of upstream face 3:1, slope of downstream face 3:1, and height of dam above water line when full 3.0 feet. The area submerged by the reservoir, when full, will be 3.75 acres and the maximum depth of water will be 21.0 feet.

This permit is subject to conditions as follows:

- 1. The structure shall be constructed, operated and maintained in accordance with the approved plans & specifications and with the design intent.
- 2. The structure shall be constructed under the supervision of a registered engineer licensed in Oregon. No water shall be stored until this department receives written certification from the engineer that construction has been completed in accordance with the approved plans and specifications, and written authorization for storage is received from this department.
- 3. The outlet gate shall be cycled at least once each year in order to assure smooth operation.

- 4. The embankment and spillway channel shall be kept clear of trees and brush.
- 5. The embankment shall be kept free of burrowing animals.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before August 18, 1989, and shall be completed on or before October 1, 1990.

This application was reviewed and considered by the Water Resources Commission on August 5, 1988.

This permit is for the beneficial use of water. By law, the land use associated with this water use must be in compliance with statewide land-use goals and any local acknowledged land-use plan. It is possible that the land use you propose may not be allowed if it is not in keeping with the goals and the acknowledged plan. Your city or county planning agency can advise you about the land-use plan in your area.

This right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
