is hereby issued a permit to construct TWO RESERVOIRS BEING POND 2 & STORAGE OF WATER FROM UNNAMED STREAM 1; POND 3 & STORAGE OF WATER FROM UNNAMED STREAM 2 to be appropriated under APPLICATION 69438, PERMIT 50276 for NURSERY OPERATIONS.

The permit to store these waters is granted under Reservoir Application R-69437 with a date of priority of OCTOBER 30, 1987. The amount of water entitled to be stored each year under such right, for the purposes aforesaid, shall not exceed 10.7 ACRE-FEET, BEING 9.0 AF IN POND 2 & 1.7 AF IN POND 3.

The ponds will be located in the:

NW 1/4 SW 1/4, Section 30, T 1 S, R 3 W, WM;

Storage will be in two ponds excavated below ground level. The area submerged by Pond 2, when full, will be 1.0 acre and the maximum depth of water will be 10.0 feet.

The area submerged by Pond 3, when full, will be 0.21 acre and the maximum depth of water will be 10.0 feet.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before August 29, 1989, and shall be completed on or before October 1, 1990.
