Application for a Permit to Construct a Reservoir and to Store for Beneficial Use the Unappropriated Waters of the State of Oregon

I, Lee E. Bechtold (Name of Applicant)

of Cottage Grove B B Route (Mailing Address)

State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to construct the following described reservoir and to store the unappropriated waters of the State of Oregon, subject to existing rights.

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

1. The name of the proposed reservoir is Bechtold Res.

2. The name of the stream from which the reservoir is to be filled and the appropriation made is unnamed stream tributary of Coast Fork Willamette River

3. The amount of water to be stored is 2.28 acre feet.

4. The use to be made of the impounded water is irrigation (Irrigation, power, domestic supply, etc.)

5. The location of the proposed reservoir will be in Sec. 32 (Give sections or townships to be submerged) Tp. 22 S., R. 3 W., W. M., in the county of Lane

(a) State whether situated in channel of running stream and give character of material at outlet in channel

(b) If not in channel of running stream, state how it is to be filled. If through a feed canal, give name and dimensions

6. The dam will be located in SW 1/4 SW 1/4, Sec. 32, Tp. 22 S., R. 3 W., W. M. The maximum height will be 20 feet above stream bed or ground surface on center line of dam. The length on top will be 133 feet; length on bottom 50 feet; width on top 20 feet; slope of front or water side 3:1; slope on back 2:1; height of dam above water line when full 4 feet.

7. The construction of dam, the material of which it is to be built, and method of protection from waves are as follows: Clay and Cement

No wave action.

8. The location of wasteway with dimensions are as follows: south end of dam. (State whether over or around the dam)

8 ft. wide and 4 ft. deep.

9. The location of outlet from the proposed reservoir, with character of construction and dimensions, are as follows: through dam, 7 ft. from center of dam. (State whether through or around the proposed dam)

18 in. concrete pipe.

10. The area submerged by the proposed reservoir, when full, will be 0.38 acres, with a maximum depth of water of 16 feet; and approximate mean depth of water 6 feet.

11. The estimated cost of the proposed work is \$ 1200.00

12. Construction work will begin on or before One year after approval

13. Construction work will be completed on or before two yrs. " "

The right hereunder shall be limited to the storage of 2.28 acre feet.

The priority date of this permit is July 28, 1950

Actual construction work shall begin on or before June 15, 1952

and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1953 ~~Extended to Oct. 1, 1954~~
