Application for a Permit to Construct a Reservoir and to Store for Beneficial Use the Unappropriated Waters of the State of Oregon

The W. A. Woodard Lumber Company, a corporation (Name of Applicant)

State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to construct the following described reservoir and to store the unappropriated waters of the State of Oregon, subject to existing rights.

1. The name of the proposed reservoir is 25 acre addition to the W. A. Woodard Lumber Company Log Pond

2. The name of the stream from which the reservoir is to be filled and the appropriation made is Coast Fork of Willamette

tributary of Willamette River

3. The amount of water to be stored is One hundred eighty nine acre feet.

4. The use to be made of the impounded water is For Log Storage (Irrigation, power, domestic supply, etc.)

5. The location of the proposed reservoir will be in Sec. SE 1/4 S. 5, Tp 21 S., R 3 W (Give sections or townships to be submerged) Tp., R., W. M., in the county of Lane

(a) State whether situated in channel of running stream and give character of material at outlet Pond Project is outside of river channel, and entirely on property owned by the applicant.

(b) If not in channel of running stream, state how it is to be filled.
