PERMIT TO CONSTRUCT A RESERVOIR AND TO
STORE FOR BENEFICIAL USE THE PUBLIC WATERS

THIS PERMIT IS HEREBY ISSUED TO

to construct WETLAND ENHANCEMENT RESERVOIR and store the waters of AN UNNAMED STREAM, a tributary of ROCK CREEK, to be appropriated under APPLICATION 69905, PERMIT 50702, for WETLAND ENHANCEMENT FOR WILDLIFE.

This Permit to store waters is issued approving Reservoir Application R-69904. The date of priority is MAY 15, 1989. The amount of water entitled to be stored each year is not more than 0.85 acre-foot.

The dam will be located as follows:

SW 1/4 SE 1/4, SECTION 4, T 1 S, R 2 W, W.M.

The maximum height of the dam will be 4.0 feet above the stream bed or ground surface at the centerline. The top width will be 8.0 feet, slope of upstream face 3:1, slope of downstream face 2:1, and height of dam above water line when full 0.4 foot. The area submerged by the reservoir, when full, will be 0.3 acre and the maximum depth of water will be 3.6 feet.

The area to be submerged by the reservoir is described as follows:

SW 1/4 SE 1/4
SECTION 4
TOWNSHIP 1 SOUTH, RANGE 2 WEST, W.M.

The storage of water allowed herein is subject to the installation and maintenance of an outlet pipe, or the provision of other means to evacuate water when determined necessary by the Water Resources Director to satisfy prior downstream rights.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before AUGUST 21, 1990, and shall be completed on or before October 1, 1991. The reservoir shall be filled, and complete application of the stored water to the use shall be made on or before October 1, 1992.

This permit is for the storage of water for future beneficial use without waste. By law, the land use associated with this water use must be in compliance with statewide land use goals and any local acknowledged land-use plan.

The storage of water allowed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
