for BENEFICIAL USE the PUBLIC WATERS

is hereby issued a permit to construct NURSERY RESERVOIR AND STORE WATERS FROM SOUTH YAMHILL RIVER, A TRIBUTARY OF YAMHILL RIVER, TO BE APPROPRIATED UNDER APPLICATION 69723, PERMIT 50713, for RELATED NURSERY USE AND CONTAINERIZED NURSERY STOCK USE.

The permit to store these waters is granted under Reservoir Application R-69744 with a date of priority of OCTOBER 27, 1988. The amount of water entitled to be stored each year under such right, for the purposes aforesaid, shall not exceed 14.42 ACRE-FEET.

The dam will be located in the:

NW 1/4 NE 1/4, Section 33, T 4 S, R 4 W, WM.

The maximum height will be 7.4 feet above the stream bed or ground surface at the centerline. The top width will be 10.0 feet, slope of upstream face 1:2.1, slope of downstream face 1:2.6, and height of dam above water line when full 1.0 foot. The area submerged by the reservoir, when full, will be 1.5 acres and the maximum depth of water will be 13.0 feet.

The area submerged by the reservoir is located in:

The storage of water allowed herein is subject to the installation and maintenance of an outlet pipe, or to provide other means to evacuate water when determined necessary by the Water Resources Director to satisfy prior downstream rights.

This permit is subject to conditions as follow:

1. The structure shall be operated and maintained in accordance with the approved plans and specifications and with the design intent.
2. The embankment shall be kept clear of trees, brush and other debris.
3. The embankment shall be kept free of burrowing animals.
4. The dam shall be constructed under the supervision of a registered professional engineer.

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Reservoir filling would be limited to the period between November 1 through May 31 of each year.

The proposed project was reviewed and approved by the Water Resources Commission on May 26, 1989.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before August 23, 1990, and shall be completed on or before October 1, 1991. The reservoir shall be filled, and complete application of the stored water to the use shall be made on or before October 1, 1992.

This permit is for the beneficial use of water. By law, the land use associated with this water use must be in compliance with statewide land-use goals and any local acknowledged land-use plan. It is possible that the land use you propose may not be allowed if it is not in keeping with the goals and the acknowledged plan. Your city or county planning agency can advise you about the land-use plan in your area.
