STORE FOR BENEFICIAL USE THE PUBLIC WATERS

to construct A RESERVOIR and store the waters of MIDDLE FORK HOOD RIVER, a tributary of HOOD RIVER, to be appropriated under Application 61201, Permit 50763, for RECREATION.

This Permit to store waters is issued approving Reservoir Application R-61200. The date of priority is OCTOBER 13, 1989. The amount of water entitled to be stored each year is not more than 9.0 ACRE-FEET.

The dam will be located as follows:

NE 1/4 SW 1/4, SECTION 31, T 1 N, R 10 E, W.M.

The maximum height of the dam will be 9.75 feet above the stream bed or ground surface at the centerline. The top width will be 17 feet, slope of upstream face 1:1, slope of downstream face 1:1, and height of dam above water line when full 1.5 feet. The area submerged by the reservoir, when full, will be 1.5 acres and the maximum depth of water will be 11.0 feet.

The area to be submerged by the reservoir is located within:

E 1/2 SW 1/4  
SECTION 31  
TOWNSHIP 1 NORTH, RANGE 10 EAST, W.M.

The storage of water allowed herein is subject to the installation and maintenance of an outlet pipe, or the provision of other means to evacuate water when determined necessary by the Water Resources Director to satisfy prior downstream rights.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before OCTOBER 27, 1990, and shall be completed on or before October 1, 1991. The reservoir shall be filled, and complete application of the stored water to the use shall be made on or before October 1, 1992.

This permit is for the storage of water for future beneficial use without waste. By law, the land use associated with this water use must be in compliance with statewide land use goals and any local acknowledged land-use plan.

The storage of water allowed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
