THIS PERMIT IS HEREBY ISSUED TO

to construct TWO UNNAMED RESERVOIRS and store the waters of DRAINAGE TRIBUTARIES OF TUALATIN RIVER, to be appropriated under Application 69787, Permit 50805, for NURSERY OPERATIONS.

This Permit to store waters is issued approving Reservoir Application R-69786. The date of priority is MAY 22, 1989. The amount of water entitled to be stored each year is not more than 9.0 ACRE-FEET, BEING 7.5 AF FROM DRAINAGE TRIBUTARY TO UNNAMED STREAM 1 AND 1.5 AF FROM DRAINAGE TRIBUTARY TO UNNAMED STREAM 2.

The dams will be located as follows:

POND 1 SE 1/4 SW 1/4, SECTION 30, T 1 S, R 3 W, W.M.

The maximum height of the dam will be 6.5 feet above the stream bed or ground surface at the centerline. The top width will be 10.0 feet, slope of upstream face 3:1, slope of downstream face 3:1, and height of dam above water line when full 2.6 feet. The area submerged by the reservoir, when full, will be 1.38 acres and the maximum depth of water will be 11.0 feet.

POND 2 NE 1/4 SW 1/4, SECTION 30, T 1 S, R 3 W, W.M.

The maximum height of the dam will be 5.0 feet above the stream bed or ground surface at the centerline. The top width will be 7.0 feet, slope of upstream face 3:1, slope of downstream face 2:1, and height of dam above water line when full 2.6 feet. The area submerged by the reservoir, when full, will be 0.31 acre and the maximum depth of water will be 9.4 feet.

The area to be submerged by the reservoirs is described as follows:

NE 1/4 SW 1/4 POND 2 SE 1/4 SW 1/4 POND 1 SECTION 30 TOWNSHIP 1 SOUTH, RANGE 3 WEST, W.M.

The storage of water allowed herein is subject to the installation and maintenance of an outlet pipe, or the provision of other means to evacuate water when determined necessary by the Water Resources Director to satisfy prior downstream rights.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before NOVEMBER 27, 1990, and shall be completed on or before October 1, 1991. The reservoir shall be filled, and complete application of the stored water to the use shall be made on or before October 1, 1992.

This permit is for the storage of water for future beneficial use without waste. By law, the land use associated with this water use must be in compliance with statewide land use goals and any local acknowledged land-use plan.

The storage of water allowed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
