THIS PERMIT IS HEREBY ISSUED TO

to construct MITIGATION POND RESERVOIR and store the waters of COLUMBIA RIVER, a tributary of PACIFIC OCEAN, to be appropriated under Application 69681, Permit 50880, for WILDLIFE USES.

This Permit to store waters is issued approving Reservoir Application R-69680. The date of priority is AUGUST 12, 1988 for 9.0 AF and August 15, 1989 for 16.0 AF. The amount of water entitled to be stored each year is not more than 25.0 ACRE-FEET.

The dam will be located as follows:

SW 1/4 NE 1/4, SECTION 2, T 1 N, R 13 E, W.M.

The area submerged by the reservoir, when full, will be 8.0 acres and the maximum depth of water will be 3.1 feet.

The area to be submerged by the reservoir is described as follows:

SW 1/4 NE 1/4 SE 1/4 NW 1/4 SECTION 2 TOWNSHIP 1 NORTH, RANGE 13 EAST, W.M.

The storage of water allowed herein is subject to the installation and maintenance of an outlet pipe, or the provision of other means to evacuate water when determined necessary by the Water Resources Director to satisfy prior downstream rights.

This project was considered and approved by the Water Resources Commission on February 12, 1990.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before FEBRUARY 16, 1991, and shall be completed on or before October 1, 1991. The reservoir shall be filled, and complete application of the stored water to the use shall be made on or before October 1, 1992.

Failure to comply with any of the provisions of this permit may result in action including, but not limited to restrictions on the use, civil penalties, or cancellation of the permit.

The permit is for the beneficial use of water without waste. The water user is advised that new regulations may require the use of best practical technologies or conservation practices to achieve this end.

By law, the land use associated with this water use must be in compliance with statewide land-use goals and any local acknowledged land-use plan.

The storage of water allowed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
