THIS PERMIT IS HEREBY ISSUED TO

to construct A RESERVOIR and store the waters of AN UNNAMED STREAM, a tributary of KENTUCK CREEK, to be appropriated under Application 69913, Permit 50979, for DOMESTIC USE FOR ONE FAMILY INCLUDING IRRIGATION OF NOT TO EXCEED ONE-HALF ACRE LAWN AND NONCOMMERCIAL GARDEN.

This Permit is issued approving Reservoir Application R-70342. The date of priority is MAY 10, 1990. The amount of water entitled to be stored each year is not more than 0.2 ACRE-FOOT.

The dam will be located as follows:

SE 1/4 SE 1/4, SECTION 34, T 24 S, R 12 W, W.M.; 782.08 FEET NORTH AND 544.48 FEET WEST FROM SE CORNER, SECTION 34.

The area submerged by the reservoir, when full, will be 0.08 acre and the maximum depth of water will be 8.0 feet.

The area to be submerged by the reservoir is located within:

SE 1/4 SE 1/4 SECTION 34 TOWNSHIP 24 SOUTH, RANGE 12 WEST, W.M.

The storage of water allowed herein is subject to the installation and maintenance of an outlet pipe, or the provisions of other means to evacuate water when determined necessary by the Water Resources Director to satisfy prior downstream rights.

Acutal construction work shall begin on or before ,JUNE 18, 1991 and shall be completed on or before October 1, 1992. The reservoir shall ,JUNE 18, 1991 and be filled, and complete application of the stored water to the use shall be made on or before October 1, 1993.

Failure to comply with any of the provisions of this permit may result in action including, but not limited to, restrictions on the use, civil penalties, or cancellation of the permit.

The permit is for the beneficial use of water without waste. The water user is advised that new regulations may require the use of best practical technologies or conservation practices to achieve this end.

By law, the land use associated with this water use must be in compliance with statewide land-use goals and any local acknowledged land-use plan.

The storage of water allowed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
