PERMIT TO CONSTRUCT A RESERVOIR AND TO
STORE FOR BENEFICIAL USE THE PUBLIC WATERS

THIS PERMIT IS HEREBY ISSUED TO

to construct THREE RESERVOIRS and store the waters of J.R. CREEK, a tributary of COW CREEK, to be appropriated under Application 69977, Permit 51037, for LIVESTOCK.

This Permit is issued approving Reservoir Application R-70428. The date of priority is JUNE 21, 1990. The amount of water entitled to be stored each year is not more than 3.0 ACRE-FEET, BEING 1.0 AF IN EACH RESERVOIR.

The dams will be located as follows:

NE 1/4 SW 1/4, NW 1/4 SE 1/4, SW 1/4 SE 1/4, SECTION 11, T 32 S, R 5 W, W.M.

The area submerged by the reservoirs, when full, will be 0.8 acre total and the maximum depth of water in each reservoir will be 6.5 feet.

The area to be submerged by the reservoirs is located within:

N 1/2 SW 1/4
W 1/2 SE 1/4
SECTION 11
TOWNSHIP 32 SOUTH, RANGE 5 WEST, W.M.

The point of diversion is located 2000 FEET NORTH AND 930 FEET EAST FROM SW CORNER, SECTION 11.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before AUGUST 6, 1991, and shall be completed on or before October 1, 1992. The reservoir shall be filled, and complete application of the stored water to the use shall be made on or before October 1, 1993.

Failure to comply with any of the provisions of this permit may result in action including, but not limited to, restrictions on the use, civil penalties, or cancellation of the permit.

The permit is for the beneficial use of water without waste. The water user is advised that new regulations may require the use of best practical technologies or conservation practices to achieve this end.

By law, the land use associated with this water use must be in compliance with statewide land-use goals and any local acknowledged land-use plan.

The storage of water allowed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
