PERMIT TO CONSTRUCT A RESERVOIR AND TO STORE FOR BENEFICIAL USE THE PUBLIC WATERS

THIS PERMIT IS HEREBY ISSUED TO

to construct AN UNNAMED RESERVOIR and store the waters of AN UNNAMED STREAM, a tributary of DEER CREEK, for WILDLIFE HABITAT.

This Permit is issued approving Reservoir Application R-70507. The date of priority is JULY 24, 1990. The amount of water entitled to be stored each year is not more than 1.5 ACRE-FEET.

The dam will be located as follows:

SE 1/4 NW 1/4, SECTION 20, T 27 S, R 5 W, W.M.; 570 FEET NORTH AND 470 FEET WEST FROM C 1/4 CORNER, SECTION 20.

The area submerged by the reservoir, when full, will be 0.4 acre and the maximum depth of water will be 5.5 feet.

The area to be submerged by the reservoir is located within:

SE 1/4 NW 1/4
SECTION 20
TOWNSHIP 27 SOUTH, RANGE 5 WEST, W.M.

Use under this permit is limited to the reservoir area. This permit does not provide for appropriation of water for maintaining the water level or maintaining a suitable fresh water condition.

When in the judgment of the Watermaster it becomes necessary to regulate waters of the stream system, storage of water in the reservoir shall be subject to the installation of suitable devices for measuring all incoming natural flows and outflows from the reservoir or passing all incoming natural flows. The types and plans for such devices shall be approved by the Watermaster and shall be installed under the general supervision of said Watermaster.

The storage of water allowed herein is subject to the installation and maintenance of an outlet pipe, or the provisions of other means to evacuate water when determined necessary by the Water Resources Director to satisfy prior downstream rights.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before SEPTEMBER 4, 1991, and shall be completed on or before October 1, 1992. The reservoir shall be filled, and complete application of the stored water to the use shall be made on or before October 1, 1993.

Failure to comply with any of the provisions of this permit may result in action including, but not limited to, restrictions on the use, civil penalties, or cancellation of the permit.

The storage of water allowed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
