PERMIT TO CONSTRUCT A RESERVOIR AND TO STORE FOR BENEFICIAL USE THE PUBLIC WATERS

THIS PERMIT IS HEREBY ISSUED TO

to construct FOUR OFF-CHANNEL RESERVOIRS and store the waters of SCOTT CREEK, a tributary of UMPQUA RIVER, for LIVESTOCK.

This Permit to store waters is issued approving Reservoir Application R-70183. The date of priority is JANUARY 30, 1990. The amount of water entitled to be stored each year is not more than 0.47 ACRE-FOOT (AF), being 0.20 AF in Reservoir 1, 0.03 AF in Reservoir 2, 0.18 AF in Reservoir 3 and 0.06 AF in Reservoir 4.

The dams will be located as follows:

RESERVOIR 3 & 4 - SE 1/4 SE 1/4, SECTION 2, RESERVOIR 2 - SW 1/4 SE 1/4, SECTION 2, AND RESERVOIR 1 - NW 1/4 NE 1/4, SECTION 11, T 24 S, R 7 W, W.M.

The area submerged by the reservoirs, when full, will be 0.20 acre in Reservoir 1; 0.03 acre in Reservoir 2; 0.18 acre in Reservoir 3, and 0.06 acre in Reservoir 4. The maximum depth of water will be 7 feet for reservoir 1 and 8 feet for reservoirs 2, 3, & 4.

The areas to be submerged by the reservoirs are located within:

SW 1/4 SE 1/4 SE 1/4 SE 1/4 NW 1/4 NE 1/4 SECTION 11

SECTION 2

TOWNSHIP 24 SOUTH, RANGE 7 WEST, W.M.

The storage of water allowed herein is subject to the installation and maintenance of an outlet pipe, or the provision of other means to evacuate water when determined necessary by the Water Resources Director to satisfy prior downstream rights.

Use under this permit is limited to the reservoir area. This permit does not provide for appropriation of water for maintaining the water level or maintaining a suitable fresh water condition.

When in the judgment of the Watermaster it becomes necessary to regulate waters of the stream system, storage of water in the reservoir shall be subject to the installation of suitable devices for measuring all incoming natural flows. The types and plans for such devices shall be approved by the Watermaster and shall be installed under the general supervision of said Watermaster.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before November 5, 1991, and shall be completed on or before October 1, 1992. The reservoir shall be filled, and complete application of the stored water to the use shall be made on or before October 1, 1993.

Failure to comply with any of the provisions of this permit may result in action including, but not limited to restrictions on the use, civil penalties, or cancellation of the permit.
